- **Type 1:** Real or possible situations in the future. *If + present simple, ... will + base verb.*
- **Type 2:** Unreal or hypothetical situations in the present or future. *If + past simple, ... would + base verb.*
- **Type 3:** Unreal situations in the past (something that did not happen). *If + past perfect, ... would have + past participle.*
