Grammar Quick-Review

- **Used to + Verb:** Used for past habits or states that are no longer true.
 - Example: *I used to live in Paris (but I don't anymore).*
- **Be used to + [Noun / -ing]:** Used when something is normal or familiar to you.
 - Example: *I am used to the cold weather because I'm from Canada.*
- **Get used to + [Noun / -ing]:** Used for the process of becoming familiar with something.
 - Example: *I am slowly getting used to my new schedule.*
