The future perfect tense describes an action that will be completed by a certain time in the future. We form it will have + past participle. It emphasizes the completion of an action.
Example: By next year, I will have graduated from university.
The future perfect continuous tense describes an ongoing action that will continue up until a certain point in the future. We form it with will have been + verb-ing. It emphasizes the duration of the action.
Example: By 5 p.m., she will have been studying for three hours.
